Breaking Changes

11053202 Webservices now use DB-Configuration

The configured REST API web services in Wave now also apply the settings defined in the database configuration. These database settings take precedence over values specified in configuration files and will override them where applicable.

As a result, it is crucial to thoroughly test the configured web services when upgrading to this release to ensure that no unintended configuration changes have occurred.
